
To complete the fishing syllabus the members look forward to fishing at Marlo, Corinella, Murray River, Port Welshpool and Lake Eildon Pondage

The Dandenong Snooker Club now boasts seven premierships since 2010! In 2015 we won our first A Res premiership, in 2014 it was our B Res and C Prem teams, in 2012 it was also C grade, and we won two premierships in the 2010 Willis season, in B Res and C Res. A terrific achievement for a relatively small sporting club and something we can all be very proud of! To put things in perspective, we made numerous finals during the mid 90s and early 2000s without much success.

We launched into the Willis season on 15 Aug. The VBSA did not run an A Res so we were slotted into B Res instead. We also had a B Willis, C Willis and C Res. The C Res team (P. Scott, J. Auricchio, M. Lumani, R. Abdul and C. Murphy) had an excellent season but finished runners-up to Dand RSL in the grand final. After turning 3-3 at the half-way mark, they could only manage another 2 frames in the second half. The C Willis team (M. Lumani, J. Miranda, C. Murphy and A. Mansur) struggled for consistency, finishing 6th. The B Willis team (M. D’Silva, S. Logan, D. Gill and A. Perry) also had an excellent season but had to be content with runners-up to Dand RSL. But our B Res team (M. D’Silva, D. Tippett, J. Black, R. Rogers and B. Cunningham) did the club proud by winning their second premiership in a row!!! It was an incredible fight-back from 2-4, 3-6, 6-6 to a tied 13th frame and a re-spotted black. Darryl also had the highest break for the grade with a 59.

Although our results in the Pennant season were a little disappointing with only 2 teams making the semi-finals, we finished stronger in the Willis season with a premiership and 2 runners-up. The 2017 Pennant season begins 27 Feb and we are looking forward to 18 weeks of tough, competitive snooker. We are all seasoned match-play snooker addicts and I am confident we will strive for even more success.

The Snooker Club was well represented at the City of Melbourne, Victorian Snooker, Lance Pannell and National Snooker Championships. Paul James, Darryl Tippett, Jason Black, Ray Rogers, Christopher Large and Callum Murphy entered one or more of the above events. Our best showing was Darryl and Jason making the last 16 on at least two occasions, and Callum continues to improve in the under 21

events. Of course, they are competing against Victoria’s and, in some cases, Australia’s best so getting past even the first round is an achievement to be proud of.

Thanks go to all the captains for taking that extra responsibility to organise and run a team. A special thanks to Muredin for running the snooker event for the 2016 Sports Day. Thanks also to the members who sold 5 or more raffle books to ensure the Snooker Club received its full quota from raffle ticket sales. And, last, but not least, thanks to Ray for the regular table maintenance duties he carries out. All your efforts are much appreciated.

The Snooker Club is proud to boast a qualified referee and a qualified coach. We always welcome new members who are keen to represent the Dandenong Club.
